READY FOR EARLY ADOPTERS

The TrueNAS Proxmox Plugin is ready for Early Adopters and Community enthusiasts - it's still being actively developed. It's a strong fit if you're standardizing a Proxmox VE 8.x/9.x cluster on TrueNAS 25.10+, already running NFS or hand-built iSCSI, or managing multiple Proxmox clusters against one array.

If you're considering Proxmox as the solution to a challenging hypervisor renewal quote, it's worth checking out how the storage side can be simplified with TrueNAS during your evaluation process.

If you run Proxmox today, provisioning storage is still somebody's afternoon. NFS exports are quick to stand up, but Proxmox's own storage docs admit the cost; slow snapshots, and I/O blocking errors at scale. Hand-cut iSCSI LUNs skip that penalty, but add friction instead; no native snapshots before Proxmox VE 9, and every storage change becomes a change request instead of a click.

The TrueNAS Proxmox Plugin ends that. It's a Proxmox VE storage backend for TrueNAS 25.10+ that automates block storage over the API - zvols published as iSCSI LUNs or NVMe/TCP namespaces, wired into the Proxmox UI's existing operations for create, snapshot, template, clone, resize, live migration, and delete.

Why Proxmox Admins are Making the Switch

One Plugin, Full Lifecycle.

Install the plugin and work straight from Proxmox. Create, snapshot, clone, resize, and delete all run through the secure TrueNAS API, with no SSH root to the array.

Provision in a Click.

No more multi-step process of creating a zvol, then an extent, then a LUN mapping - simply add a disk to the VM from the Proxmox UI and let the plugin handle the back-end work.

Shared Block, Cluster-Wide

LUNs and namespaces stay visible to every node, so live migration just works.

No Cluster Collisions.

Dataset-per-cluster naming prevents multiple Proxmox clusters from overlapping on the same TrueNAS appliance.
